

Planning Application submitted for Sainsbury's Broxburn

Sainsbury's have this week submitted proposals for a 35,000 sq ft foodstore on land between East Mains Industrial Estate and the railway viaduct on the A89. The proposals will bring choice to the town whilst creating up to 300 new jobs.

In September last year, Sainsbury's consulted with the community and held a two day public exhibition, displaying the plans for the store. Over 100 members of the public attended the exhibition at 'The Club' on Greendykes Road, and since then, Sainsbury's has received over 800 pieces of written feedback from the local community, which showed 92% support for the proposed store.

Sainsbury's investment will bring:

- ✓ A new foodstore creating up to 300 new full and part time jobs
- ✓ A new petrol filling station
- ✓ Improved shopping choice for local residents
- ✓ Improved junction with the A89 and Peniel Place
